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Neural Therapy

Neural therapy belongs to the field of regulating medicine, and it is one of the best known and most effective natural healing methods practically without any negative side effects.

The whole body is seen as one unit with all areas connected to and influencing each other by interactive circuits (vegetative nerve-system).

Therefore, it is assumed that a large variety of pain suffered in a certain part of the body have holistic origins. The pain caused by the inflamed root of a tooth, as example, may be felt not just in the affected jaw but in an entirely different location.

In neural therapy, local anaesthetics (Lidocain, Procain) are injected at specifically defined points in order to positively influence the body's circuits.

This will activate the natural self-healing capacities enabling the body to cure illnesses on its own.

With these specifically aimed injections of local anaesthetics, chronic as well as acute conditions can be effectively fought. For problem-free treatment, however, the applying MD has to be well educated and substantially experienced in using this method.

Disruptive Field Therapy

The search for disruptive fields within the body and their treatment is a major element of neural therapy. Disruptive fields are created by inflammations of a wide variety (diseased teeth, old scars and similar are typical disruptive fields) which send out impulses via the vegetative nerve-system that almost spreads across our entire body. Those impulses may manifest themselves as pain or chronic disease within the affected area or in an entirely different part of the body.

Therefore, the location, where pain is actually felt doesn't necessarily have to be the disruptive field itself. Only if the origin of pain is known, successful treatment can be applied, and this is, where disruptive field therapy sets in. Once the focus of inflammation is found, the process of impulses being sent out can be interrupted by the injection of local anaesthetics cutting the alliance between reason and effect at the same time.

The pain acutely felt in a certain area of the body is locally treated as well as the actual disruptive field, so that the patient is not only relieved from his pain instantly but also on a long-term basis.

Treatment

Lidocain and Procain are generally injected. These substances have anti-inflammatory as well as blood flow improving effects. The area of the pain actually suffered is treated or - within the disruptive field therapy - the focus of inflammation (old scars or teeth for instance); often, both locations are tackled simultaneously. Apart from rarely occurring allergenic response or indigestibility, the local anaesthetics have no side effects whatsoever.

Explicitly positive effects with conditions like:

- Pain suffered within the spinal cord, slipped discs
- Sciatica problems, lumbago
- Muscle- or joint rheumatism
- Headache, migraine
- Ringing in the ears, tinnitus
- Shingles
- Inflammation of the nasal side cavities
- Hay fever
- Asthma
- Allergies
- Circulatory disorder in legs and arms
- Degenerative joint disease
